

Notice of review of polling districts, polling places and polling stations

In accordance with the Representation of the People Act 1983 as amended by the Electoral Administration Act 2006 notice is hereby given that Norwich City Council will be conducting a review of polling districts, polling places and polling stations in its area.

Details of the existing polling districts, polling places and polling stations together with the relevant maps, are available for public inspection at main reception, City Hall, St Peters Street, Norwich, during normal office hours. This information is also available on the council's website www.norwich.gov.uk on the election services pages.

There will be a consultation period which will commence on **Monday 4 August**, **2014**.

The Returning Officer will be invited to make comments on the review and these will be published on the council's website when received.

Representations and comments are also invited from:

- electors within the Norwich south or Norwich north parliamentary areas (the council would particularly welcome comments from disabled residents)
- any person or organisation which has particular expertise in relation to access for people with any type of disability.
- MEPs, MPs and councillors
- local political parties

Representations that changes be made should, if possible, give alternative places that can be used as polling stations and polling places.
