Publication of a Development Plan Document and Statement of Representations Procedure

Norwich City Council gives notice that it has published the submission report of the development plan document known as the 'Northern City Centre Area Action Plan'.

The plan is intended to become part of the Development Plan for Norwich when it is adopted, following a Public Examination.

Subject matter: policies and proposals for the regeneration of the area and redevelopment of specific sites over the period 2008-2016.

Area covered: the area is that bounded by the River Wensum, Bakers Road, Magpie Road, Bull Close Road, and Whitefriars.

Period for representations: Representations must be received during the period 8th December 2008 and 27th February 2009 (5pm).

Address for representations: representations may be made in writing to Paul Rao, Planning Policy and Projects Manager, City Hall, St Peters Street, Norwich NR2 1NH. Representations may also be made electronically by downloading a response form from the Council's website www.norwich.gov.uk, and sending it by email to LDF@norwich.gov.uk.

Availability of documents: The submission proposals document and other supporting submission documents will be available at City Hall during normal office hours (9am - 5pm) and at the Forum, Millennium Plain, Norwich NR2 1TF. They are also available on the Council's website at www.norwich.gov.uk.

Representations procedure: Representations may be accompanied by a request to be notified of any of the following:

- that the area action plan has been submitted for independent examination,
- that the inspector's report of the independent examination into the area action plan has been published, and
- that the area action plan has been adopted.
