The schemes

All three schemes are located just off Heigham Street to the north-west of the city centre.

All schemes are within walking distance of the local shops, GP surgery and the city centre.

Local bus services to the city centre and other destinations are also available close by.

The aims of our sheltered housing service

- To provide comfortable and practical rented accommodation where people over 60 years of age can feel safe and secure.
- To enable people to live together independently for longer.
- To facilitate opportunities for tenants to enjoy activities.
- To enable tenants to receive a level of support that allows them to successfully maintain their tenancy and live independently.

Accommodation

- Accommodation is provided across the three schemes.
- 20 one bedroom flats at Bailey Court, 6 at Russell Street, 23 at Causeway Close.
- No lift access to first floor.

Scheme includes

- A dedicated support worker.
- A dedicated sheltered housing officer.

- Alarm call system linked to Norwich Community Alarm Service (NCAS).
- Heat and smoke detectors linked to NCAS.
- Car parking.

Eligibility

The scheme is for people who:

- are usually above 60 years of age
- are a resident in the Norwich city council area
- live outside the council area but have a strong social reason for needing to move to the area.

To move to **Bailey Court, Russell Street or Causeway Close** please contact Norwich City Council on **0344 980 3333** and speak to our home options team who will be able to process your application over the telephone. All properties are advertised weekly on our website and are allocated via choice based lettings (CBL).
