The scheme

Harry Perry Close has 40 one bedroom bungalows specifically designed for older people.

The scheme is located to the

south of the city off Ipswich Road, within walking distance of the local shop, library, GP surgery and post office.

Local bus services to the city centre are also available from close by.

The scheme features a communal lounge which acts as a meeting place for residents. A day opportunities service is held weekly which allows tenants to benefit from further activities and a cooked lunch for a small charge.

The aims of our sheltered housing service

- To provide comfortable and practical rented accommodation where people over 60 years of age can feel safe and secure.
- To enable people to live together independently for longer.
- To facilitate opportunities for tenants to enjoy activities.
- To enable tenants to receive a level of support that allows them to successfully maintain their tenancy and live independently.

Accommodation

- 40 one bedroom bungalows.
- Communal lounge and kitchen.
- Guestroom.
- Communal laundry with washing machines and tumble driers.

Scheme includes

- A dedicated support worker.
- A dedicated sheltered housing officer.

- Alarm call system linked to Norwich Community Alarm Service (NCAS).
- Heat and smoke detectors linked to NCAS.
- Induction loop for the hard of hearing in the communal lounge.
- · Car parking.

Eligibility

The scheme is for people who:

- are usually above 60 years of age
- are a resident in the Norwich city council area
- live outside the council area but have a strong social reason for needing to move to the area.
