The scheme

Longbow Close is located to the south of the city and has 31 one bedroom flats specifically designed for older people. The scheme is within short walking distance of a local shop, library, GP surgery and post office.

Local bus services to the city centre are also available close by.

The communal lounge acts as a meeting place where residents can enjoy weekly coffee mornings, bingo and other activities.

There is also a weekly lunch club.

The aims of our sheltered housing service

- To provide comfortable and practical rented accommodation where people over 60 years of age can feel safe and secure.
- To enable people to live together independently for longer.
- To facilitate opportunities for tenants to enjoy activities.
- To enable tenants to receive a level of support that allows them to successfully maintain their tenancy and live independently.

Accommodation

- A scheme of ground and first floor flats, no lift access.
- Communal lounge and kitchen.
- Guestroom.
- Communal laundry with washing machines and tumble dryer.
- 24 hour door entry system to give additional home security.

Scheme includes

A dedicated support worker.

- A dedicated sheltered housing officer.
- Alarm call system linked to Norwich Community Alarm Service (NCAS).
- Heat and smoke detectors linked to NCAS.
- Induction loop for the hard of hearing in the communal lounge.
- Car parking.

Eligibility

The scheme is for people who:

- are usually above 60 years of age
- are a resident in the Norwich city council area
- live outside the council area but have a strong social reason for needing to move to the area.
