

## Allotment rule breaches

Area	Breaches of the allotment rules	Enforcement
<b>Livestock</b>	Rabbits not kept with others	Case by case
<b>Livestock</b>	Keeping livestock other than hens, rabbits or bees eg cockerels	From 30 September 2011 , unless complaints received before that date
<b>Livestock</b>	Hen structure not built to the recommended size	Any new structures must comply
<b>Livestock</b>	Failure to apply for permission to build a hen structure	Any new structures must comply
<b>Livestock</b>	Rabbit structure not built to the recommended size	Any new structures must comply
<b>Structures</b>	Failure to get written permission to install a structure	Any new structures must comply
<b>Structures</b>	Failure to comply with the conditions and guidance for erecting a structure	Any new structures must comply
<b>Structures</b>	Use of concrete on your allotment	Any new structures must comply
<b>Structure</b>	Not using your allotment mainly for the production of fruit and vegetables	Any new structures must comply
<b>Structure</b>	Use of fencing over 2m high	Any new structures(subject to planning)
<b>Plot</b>	Failure to control woody weeds	From 7 June 2011
<b>Plot</b>	Use of barbed wire	From 7 June 2011
<b>Plot</b>	Storage of items not for use on the allotment	From 7 June 2011
<b>Plot</b>	Storage of materials without using them for a period longer than 6 months	From 7 September 2011
