Feedback to residents

In March residents, council officers and police attended Dibden Road supported living scheme to discuss local issues that concerned residents. We would like to thank everyone who was able to come along and take part.

Below is a summary of the general neighbourhood issues that were raised, however, we have not included Individual or personal issues.

Issue One:

You told us... Visibility is difficult when driving a car over the junction with Crome Road. It was suggested that the situation could be improved by adding yellow lines to the school markings near the entrance to the school on Crome Road and possibly adding permit parking in the area.

City council response: We have passed on your concerns to our transport department who will register this suggestion and to consider this should a budget become available.

Issue Two:

You raised concerns about ... Vehicles are sometimes parked fully on the foot path on Crome Road. When this happens it means that pedestrians are forced to use the road for access.

City council response: The local police team are aware of this issue. If vehicles block the footpath so that, for example, wheelchairs or buggies cannot pass by, then residents have the option to phone the police's non-emergency number 101 with the vehicle registration. The police may be able to help by contacting the owner or having it moved.
