Resident feedback

In August, the North Neighbourhood team joined the events team and their partners for the Play Day held at the Mile Cross Garden on Suckling Avenue.

The community event, organised by the Norwich City Council Events Team was well attended by members of the community who enjoyed the free activities which had been organised.

In the North Team's gazebo we encouraged children to get involved in making bird feeders, while parents were able to talk to local officers and Councillors about any concerns they may have had regarding their area.

- **Make your own birdfeeder.** We encouraged children to make their own bird feeder from bird seed; raisins; peanuts and lard. The children had great fun and took home what they had made to put in their gardens.

Summary of neighbourhood issues:

Queries and advice around recycling was the main topic with some people requiring larger bins for their recycling since the changes or wanting to start recycling food waste.

The City Council's response:

Leaflets were available and advice was given to those who had any concerns or wanted to recycle more. Residents were also able to order replacement recycling and food waste bins/caddies.
