Norwich City Council has been trying hard recently to encourage people to take their health seriously and to participate in more exercise. We understand that sometimes people find gym membership too expensive and difficult to get to because of travel arrangements.

Last summer we installed outdoor gym equipment in Woodrow Pilling Park that was free to use. This has proved to be very popular and well used by lots of different people of all ages, shapes and sizes. Due to its popularity we thought the residents of Heartsease may like something similar. However the equipment is expensive to install, and we only want to install it if people will use it.

During early January Jeff Compton (Community engagement officer) and Janine Paice (Neighbourhood officer) carried out a door knocking/letter drop evening, surveying 350 local people to get feedback about whether they were in favour of an outdoor gym and the types of equipment they might be interested in. Students of the Open academy were also surveyed.
