On 4th November council officers, councillors and the police met with residents of Britannia Road, Vincent Road and Mons Avenue at the Britannia Café to discuss the ongoing local issues concerning the traffic movements and traffic noise when people met regularly on the car park overlooking the heath. We would like to thank everyone who took the time to talk to us.

Kieran Yates the traffic planning officer for the city council explained that money might be put aside to deal specifically with this issue. He gave each of the attendees of the meeting a copy of a questionnaire that he had produced, which identified some of the options that might be possible to help to eliminate the issues and asked them for their suggestions. A discussion regarding these options followed.

He explained the next step was for him to take their thoughts back to his team to be added to other considerations and that this would need to happen made before any final decision was made.

Decisions like these need to be put before a meeting of elected councillors for their approval.

If this is successful we could call another meeting to discuss the next steps.
