## Resident feedback

During the summer months the neighbourhood officer was contacted by a resident in Calvert Street who was concerned about a leylandi tree in the communal garden behind her property.

The leylandi tree had become extremely large and the situation was being made worse by a climbing plant which had attached itself to the tree and was adding to the overall weight and volume of the leylandi. The neighbourhood officer arranged to meet the arboricultural technician on site who agreed the best course of action would be to remove the tree and replace it with something smaller and more suitable; as if the current leylandi was left in situ it could cause potential problems to the buildings in the future.

All residents who share the communal garden have now been contacted with a choice of 3 replacement varieties of tree. The consultation closes on 19<sup>th</sup> December, after this date the council will count up the votes and make a decision based on the majority of votes received
