## Resident feedback

During June, the South neighbourhood team held an annual road show at the Jenny Lind Community Games on Saturday 28th June 2014.

The community event, organised by a partnership led by the Trinity Church, was held at Jenny Lind Park and well attended by members of the community. There were a variety of different activities for children to take part in as well as a number of different stalls.

In the council's gazebo we held a number of activities:

- **Pledge Board.** We encouraged residents to tell us what they will do to make their neighbourhood a better place to live and pin it to our pledge wall. Residents were keen to think about what they could do and we had a number of pledges put up on the wall. There was a strong feeling amongst residents to reduce litter and a number of residents vowed to pick up litter and encourage their friends to do the same. The other main commitment from local residents was to be more community-minded with pledges to be friendly, get to know neighbours, smile at people and get involved in helping with community projects.
- **Activity Rug:** We provided children with colouring pens and paper so they could draw some pictures of their neighbourhood. Some children did colouring instead. They all enjoyed taking part and produced some interesting results.
