

Basis of agreement for free or subsidised use of Goals Soccer Centre, Norwich

1. Who can register to use the pitches free of charge or at a subsidised rate?

- a) Members of registered community groups and registered youth groups within the city of Norwich area.
- b) Children under the age of 18 years who are members of registered children's groups within the city of Norwich area.
- c) Junior football clubs (up to 16 years olds) and associations within the city of Norwich area that have achieved FA Charter Standard club status.
- d) And such other category as may be pre-agreed with the Norwich City Council's sports development team.

Provided that they have preregistered with Goals Norwich for use of the facilities (refer to point three for details of how to register).

2. How many pitches can be booked and when?

"Term" means a reference to one of the three school terms falling during any calendar year on which school buildings in Norwich City centre shall be open

on weekdays for the provision of education to children (disregarding training days and half-term holidays) and term time shall exclude holiday periods between school terms and half-term holidays.

3. How do eligible groups and organisations register?

In the first instance contact Norwich City Council sports development team to check whether your organisation is eligible to register for free/subsidised use of Goals pitches. The council will then forward your details to Goals Soccer Centre, Norwich, who will provide a membership registration form for you to complete and return to Goals. There is no charge for this registration.

A condition of registration and membership is that use of the facilities will be subject to Goals rules and regulations.

4. Booking arrangements

A maximum of one month and a minimum of eight days written/email notice must be sent to Goals requesting use of the facility.

Goals management reserves the right to refuse use of the facilities as set out in this agreement if it reasonably considers that usage may cause injury or damage to the facilities, or that the facilities are required to be closed for the purposes of maintenance.

If Goals management consider that the facilities which have been booked as above are not being used regularly by a registered group it may cancel any such booking and refuse to accept any further bookings made by that group.
